## COMMITTEE JOB DESCRIPTIONS

**CONVENTION:** Prepare and submit a convention budget to the board of directors for approval. Appoint necessary chairman and committees to handle all details of convention. Work closely with president and executive secretary. Make all advance arrangements with the convention site management. Plan adequate meeting spaces and reserve a block of rooms based on previous attendance. Work with Executive Secretary on mailings, tickets, convention program, and printing.

**FIELD SEED - TURF SEED - VEGETABLE SEED:** Appoint crop reporters. Solicit suggestions from committee members regarding ideas for meeting at Annual Convention. Present these plans to the Directors at their annual Mid-winter board meeting.

Responsible for all other matters which should be presented to the Committee or Board of Directors relative to the turf and field seed, or vegetable seed segment.

Advise the Legislative Committee of any changes that might occur or be projected affecting the various laws and regulations concerning field, turf, or vegetable seeds. Obtain crop information from area reporters for presentation to members at the Annual Convention. Plan and conduct seed meeting that will be of interest to the membership during the Annual Meeting of the Association.

**HISTORIAN:** Collect and save all records, pictures, minutes, programs, etc. concerning the activities of the Pacific Seed Association with the help of the executive secretary.

**LEGISLATIVE:** Act as a clearing house for state and federal legislation which may or could have an effect on seedsmen producing, marketing or distributing seed within the area covered by PSA and seeds marketed elsewhere.

To attain this objective the chairman should, at frequent intervals, be in contact with the members of the committee to point to legislative action or pending legislation as it pertains to seed. The chairman should encourage the committee members to, by correspondence, keep in contact with one another during the year on any matters of legislative nature, which may come to their attention. In exchange of such correspondence it is highly desirable for the sender to make a copy available to the chairman and each committee member.

A copy of any exchange of correspondence relating to legislative matters should also be sent to the president, first vice president, secretary-treasurer, and the executive secretary.

Experience over the years has indicated that legislative matters in a state can best be handled by seeds-men conducting business therein.

It would be extremely beneficial to PSA if the chairman of this committee could be a member of the American Seed Trade Association legislative committee. Report matters of importance to the two regular board meetings and the annual convention.

**MEMBERSHIP:** Be responsible for the solicitation of new membership in accordance with the eligibility, classification and other requirements of membership as may be prescribed by the By-laws of this association. Upon appointment to this committee, the appointee will forward to his chairman, a list of those persons, firms or corporations he will solicit for membership. The chairman will compile said lists and circularize same to the board of directors for their consideration. As soon as possible thereafter, the chairman will notify each committeeman of these prospects who are deemed eligible for membership and the committeeman will then make his formal presentation.

**NECROLOGY:** Gather information about the death of anyone connected by activity or by relationship with the seed industry in the PSA area. Secure the following information for each deceased person so connected: full name, age, company affiliated with, and/or relationship, and date of death. Assemble all such information and present to board of directors and membership at annual meeting.

**NOMINATING:** The nominating committee shall be guided in their selection of individuals to serve the association on the basis of an individual's ability, interest, and participation in the affairs of the association. The association By-laws state: "Other than the officers and the retiring president, no more than two of the other directors may reside in any one state of the United States."

The committee should be composed of past presidents. It shall be the duty of this committee to present at each annual meeting the names of Individuals to be: president, 1st vice president, 2nd vice president, secretary-treasurer, and six directors, including the retiring president.

In order to maintain an effective balance in the association's "officers' and directors structure due consideration should be given to:

1. Geographical location.
2. Only one person from any one company in any year.
3. Equitable distribution from the principal segments of the industry.
4. The president each year should, whenever possible:
  - a. Come from a different geographical location.
  - b. Come from a different segment of the Industry.

5. To maintain balance there must be a degree of flexibility in the number of years a director may serve. Normally, our association should strive for a director to serve two years.

**PUBLIC RELATIONS:** Help publicize all-important activities of the Pacific Seedsmen's Association pertinent to the Western seed industry. Assist the President of the Association in selecting the PSA Person of the Year to be honored at the Annual Meeting.

The Person of the Year to be selected shall be, preferably, a plant scientist for outstanding research in genetics, cytogenetics, or breeding of plants in the employ of a public institution. Have the committee members keep the chairman informed of outstanding events and persons in their respective areas. The Chairman is to report to the Board of Directors at the regular meetings.

**RESEARCH LIAISON:** Search for research projects that are of use or need to the seed industry and to promote all possible such projects, especially work done by governmental agencies in the PSA area. Give suitable acknowledgement to individuals who have advanced any type of seed technology by public acclaim and by presentation of PSA plaques.

Keep board and members informed of the activity of the committee so all will know of new innovations.

**SCHOLARSHIP:** Responsible for developing or improving a scholarship program applicable at the university level for agricultural colleges in the PSA area. Work with the Executive Secretary to assist investing the basic funds in a manner that will provide interest income for use as a base for the scholarship program. Disseminate information regarding the program to Agricultural Universities in the PSA area. Arrange for interviews of applicants. Arrange for scholarship awards in a manner that will provide information and material that can be used in the PSA public relations program.

## Code of Ethics

### **of the Pacific Seed Association**

To serve and develop the interest of all agriculture by improving friendly business relations between members of the Seed Trade, seed producers and seed consumers and cooperate with educational and regulatory authorities, and other interested agencies, in the development of a sound and effective seed program.

To develop, encourage, and promote among its members the highest standards of integrity and ethics in transactions between the members, between members and their customers, and with the general public.

It shall be the duty of each and every member of this Association to uphold, promote and abide by the provisions of the Constitution and By-laws of the Pacific Seed Association, and to conduct the members' business in accordance with its objects and purposes.

To assure that in all sales and contracts of sale and advertisements, the members of the Association shall practice entire good faith, shall give full and truthful representations of the quality and description of seeds sold or offered for sale, respect proprietary and varietal rights, and in their trade relations shall studiously avoid the use of terms or expressions that are false or misleading.

To cooperate with committees of the respective Legislatures, administrative officials, and Commissions of the Federal and State Governments to the end that the interest of its member firms may be thoroughly and adequately considered and understood in relation to contemplated legislation, rules and regulations, and administrative orders.

To gather and disseminate information. To make factual surveys and investigations. To prepare and publish to its memberships, bulletins and digests which will increase the efficiency of the operation of its members and increase the knowledge of its members as to their respective rights and privileges.

# CONSTITUTION of the PACIFIC SEED ASSOCIATION

As adopted by the membership at the annual meeting in Sun Valley, ID, June 3, 1959.

## ARTICLE I NAME

This association shall be known as the Pacific Seed Association.

## ARTICLE II OBJECTIVES

The objectives of this Association shall be:

The development of such relations and intimacies between the members as exist in all standard social organizations; and the cultivation of firmer business unity in which all can stand together in the effort to improve and perfect a standard of business integrity, which shall include purity of stocks, honesty of representation, carefulness of obligations, and promptness in execution. Also the discussion of all subjects of interest to, or belonging to the Seed Trade.

Obedience to the law of the land and in particular to the law regulating the sale of seeds.

The dedication of the technical and practical knowledge and service, of the Association and of its members to the improvement of agriculture and horticulture.

In all sales and contracts of sale and advertisements, the members of the Association shall practice entire good faith, shall give full and truthful representations of the quality and description of needs sold or offered for sale, shall scrupulously observe every contractual obligation, and in their trade relations shall studiously avoid the use of terms or expressions that are false or misleading.

## ARTICLE III

This Association shall not engage in any business or enterprise for profit, collect fees for any services rendered, nor contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members.

## ARTICLE IV MEMBERSHIP

The Bylaws shall provide for the number and qualifications of its members, classes of membership, the Property, voting, and other rights and privileges of each class, and the liability of each or all classes to dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof.

**ARTICLE V  
OFFICERS and DIRECTORS**

This Association shall be governed by officers and a board of directors. The Bylaws shall designate the respective titles and number of officers and directors and provide for their method of election, tenure of office, and their duties.

**ARTICLE VI  
MEETINGS**

The By-laws shall provide for regular, special, and emergency meetings of its members and directors.

**ARTICLE VII  
AMENDMENT PROCEDURE**

This Constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting there-on at the annual meeting of the Association, provided notice of such amendment shall have been sent by mail to each member at least thirty days in advance of said meeting.

**BY-LAWS  
of the Pacific Seed Association**

As adopted by the membership at the annual meeting in San Diego, California on May 25, 1965.

**ARTICLE I  
MEMBERSHIP**

**SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY.** Any person, firm or corporation being actively engaged in their present business and maintaining high standards of business ethics and agreeing to support and comply with the By-laws, Code of Ethics and Arbitration Rules of this Association, may become a member...Membership shall consist of four classes, i.e., Active Member, Associate Member, Affiliate Member and Honorary Member.

**SECTION 2. ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP.** Active Membership shall consist of recognized individuals, firms or corporations maintaining an established place of business in the states of Alaska, Arizona, California, Hawaii, ID, Nevada, Oregon, Utah, Washington, Wyoming, Montana, in Mexico, in the provinces of Alberta and British Columbia, Canada, together with other seed growers and dealers having an established branch or agent located in the above named states or provinces, regularly engaged in the distribution of seeds for planting, excepting retailers selling seed exclusively in packets.

**SECTION 3. ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP.** Associate Membership shall consist of individuals firms or corporations, which sell supplies or services to members of the seed industry, except those qualifying for active membership.

**SECTION 4, AFFILIATE MEMBERSHIP.** Affiliate Members shall be those individuals, firms or corporations who do not maintain an established place of business in the states of Alaska, Arizona, California, Hawaii, Idaho, Nevada, Oregon, Utah, Washington, Wyoming, Montana, in Mexico, in the provinces of Alberta and British Columbia, Canada, but are engaged in the distribution of seeds for planting excepting retailers selling seed exclusively in packets.

**SECTION 5. HONORARY MEMBERSHIP.** Honorary Membership may be granted an individual by unanimous vote of the Board of Directors upon recommendation of the President, and to be presented to the membership at the annual meeting. Such membership shall be exempt from annual dues. The number of recommendations is limited to one each year.

**SECTION 6. ELECTION.** Active, Associate or Affiliate members may be elected at any meeting of the Association after having been recommended by the Board of Directors. Election to membership shall be only upon the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the members entitled to vote who are present at such meeting. Voting shall be by voice vote, unless one member, entitled to vote shall request a vote by ballot, in which event such voting shall be by ballot. All applications for membership must be in writing upon the form prescribed by the Board of Directors and must be accompanied by one year's dues.

## **ARTICLE II TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP**

### **SECTION 1. EXPULSION.**

- A. A member of the corporation may be suspended or expelled from membership for conduct in violation of, or derogatory to, the principles established by the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation and by the By-laws of the corporation. Any member may file written charges of such conduct with the Executive Secretary. Upon receipt of such charges, the Executive Secretary shall transmit a copy thereof by registered mail to the member against whom the charges have been filed. Said member shall have the privilege of filing an answer to said charges provided that any answer so made shall be filed within fifteen (15) days from the time that the charges are transmitted. A copy of such answer, if any, shall be forwarded promptly by the Executive Secretary to the complaining member. The latter shall have the privilege of filing a reply to the answer, a copy of which, if any, shall be transmitted to the Executive Secretary within ten (10) days after the answer is mailed to the complaining member. The Executive Secretary of the corporation thereafter shall refer the written charges and the reply or answer thereto, to the Hearing Committee.
- B. The charges shall be investigated promptly by a committee of five (5), composed of the Chairman of the Field Seed Committee, the Chairman
- C. Upon completion of its investigation and of the hearing, if one is bad, the Hearing Committee shall find the facts and make a decision in writing which shall either:
  - (1) dismiss the charge
  - (2) suspend the offending member for a period of not more than one year, all dues to be paid during the period of suspension
  - (3) expel the offending member or

(4) take such other action as the Hearing Committee may deem advisable.

The Executive Secretary shall communicate such order of the Hearing Committee to the member against whom the charges have been made.

- D. Within twenty (20) days after the receipt of a copy of the decision of the Hearing Committee, either complainant or the defendant may appeal to the Board of Directors of the Association, by filing a written notice of appeal with the Executive Secretary. The Executive Secretary shall immediately notify the other party of the filing of such appeal.
- E. The Board of Directors shall have the Power to affirm, modify or reverse the recommendations of the Hearing Committee, by a majority vote, and its decision shall be final.
- F. The Board of Directors may, before acting on the appeal, order such further hearings on the evidence as it may elect, or may order further arguments, or may decide the case on the written record of the Hearing Committee. In the event further hearings or arguments are ordered. The original members of the Hearing Committee will continue to constitute the committee for the original charge until such time as the Board of Directors makes a final decision. The Executive Secretary shall notify the member against whom the charges are filed of the action by the Board of Directors.
- G. The name and place of any hearing provided for in this Article II shall be as fixed by the Committee or Board conducting such hearing and the time and place of such hearing shall be given to the member against whom the charges are filed, the complaining member, and such other persons as the Committee or Board designates. All such notices shall be given by mail to the address of the notices as appearing on the books and records of the corporation.
- H. Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to preclude the Board of Directors of the corporation, by appropriate action, from canceling the membership in the corporation of any member or from causing the name of any member of the corporation to be dropped from its membership roll when, in the opinion of a majority of the members of the Board, the best interests of the corporation will be served thereby. Such action may be taken by the Board of Directors at any time without notice and without assigning any reason therefore.

**SECTION 2. DELINQUENCIES.** Members whose dues have not been paid within one year from due date shall be suspended from membership.

**SECTION 3. REINSTATEMENTS.** Members who have been suspended for onpayment of dues may be formally reinstated by a majority vote of the Board of Directors provided that all back dues have been paid.

**SECTION 4. VOLUNTARY.** Any member may terminate his membership voluntarily by filing a written resignation as a member of this Association, with the Executive Secretary of this Association.

**SECTION 5. TERMINATION OF RIGHTS.** All rights of a member of this corporation or its property shall cease upon the termination of his membership from whatever cause.

**ARTICLE III  
DUES**

**SECTION 1. MEMBERS.** All Annual dues shall be established by the Board of Directors and are due and payable on January 1<sup>st</sup> each year.

**SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** In case of emergency, the Board of Directors, by unanimous vote of the entire Board, shall have the power to adjust dues or levy assessments.

**SECTION 3. SPECIAL ASSESSMENT.** Any segment of the Association. By a two-thirds vote, may assess itself for its own purpose and benefit. Such assessment to be separately accounted for in the general fund. The assessment to be subject to the approval of the Board of Directors and in conformity with the Articles of Incorporation and By-laws of this corporation.

**ARTICLE IV  
OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS**

**SECTION 1. OFFICERS.** The officers of the Association shall consist of a President, First Vice-President, Second Vice-President and Secretary-Treasurer of which two-thirds shall be Active Members.

**SECTION 2. BOARD OF DIRECTORS.** The Board of Directors shall consist of the four officers and five additional members of which two-thirds shall be active members, and the retiring president.

**SECTION 3. ELECTION PROCEDURE.** All of the elected officers and directors provided for in Sections 1 and 2 of this Article shall be elected by ballot at the annual meeting except as provided In Article VI, Section 3. A majority of the votes cast shall constitute a choice.

**SECTION 4. TENURE OF OFFICE.** All officers and the immediate past president shall serve for one year, or until their successors are elected and qualified. Directors will serve for two years.

**SECTION 5. VACANCIES .** Should the office of President be vacated, the First Vice-President shall assume that office and title. In the event of a vacancy in the office of the First Vice-President, the Second Vice-President shall assume that office and title. Any vacancy occurring in the office of Executive Secretary or the Board of Directors may be filled by a majority vote of the remaining members of the Board. In the temporary absence of the Executive Secretary, the President shall appoint an Executive Secretary pro tempore.

**ARTICLE V  
DUTIES**

**SECTION 1. PRESIDENT.** It shall be the duty of the President, or, in his absence, the First Vice-President, or in the absence of both, the Second Vice-President to preside at all Association and Directors' meetings.

The President shall appoint all regular and special committees. He shall also appoint such committees as shall be provided for by action of the Association at its meetings. He shall also appoint a Nominating Committee composed of three voting members, all of who are past presidents of the association, at least 30 days prior to the annual meeting.

**SECTION 2. VICE-PRESIDENTS.** In addition to presiding at meetings in the absence of the President as above prescribed, the First Vice-President or Second Vice-President, in that order, shall succeed to the office of President in the event of a vacancy in that office from whatever cause.

**SECTION 3. SECRETARY-TREASURER.** The Secretary-Treasurer shall have such duties and responsibilities as are from time to time required of him by the Board of Directors or the President.

**SECTION 4. EXECUTIVE SECRETARY.** In addition to the offices elected as above provided for, the Board of Directors shall employ an Executive Secretary. The Executive Secretary shall provide leadership and direction for the affairs of the Association including but not limited to advising committee chairmen, officers and members of the Board of Directors of issues of concern, including alternative solutions and recommendations supported with the necessary information to take the appropriate actions. The Executive Secretary shall be responsible to the Board. The duties and responsibilities shall be as prescribed by the Board of Directors but which in all events shall include the following:

- A. To attend all meetings of the Association and of the Board of Directors; to conduct all correspondence, and to carry into execution all orders, votes, and resolves not otherwise committed; to keep a current list of members and notify the following:
  - 1. New members of their election
  - 2. All members in advance of any meeting as provided in Article VI, Section 1 and 2, and Article VIII, Section 1.
  - 3. Members of committees of their appointments. The
  - 4. The Directors of any meeting, as provided in Article VI, Section 6. As prescribed in Article II, Section 1, herein.
- B. To scan, related publications and newsletters, and all monthly bulletins.
- C. Take a leadership position in promoting the Association. Prepare and release appropriate publicity promoting the Association as well as the interests of the regional seed industry to newspapers, trade, farm and home publications, radio and/or television, stations.
- D. To keep an accurate accounting of all receipts and disbursements of all Association funds.
- E. To assist in the necessary arrangements for all meetings
- F. Insure complete and accurate record of the activities and actions of individual committees, sub-committees and the Board of Directors is maintained in, Association files.
- G. Provide the Board of Directors with a semiannual activity report detailing actions of the Executive Secretary on behalf of the Association.
- H. Maintain a liaison with appropriate Government and/or regulatory officials and representatives within the Association's region and on a National level if so directed by the board.

- I. Maintain a liaison with individual state seed association's as well as the American Seed Trade Association and any other related organizations as appropriate.
- J. Coordinate activities and actions of the committees and other functional entities of the association's where and when applicable.

The Executive Secretary shall keep an account of all Association Money received and expended; shall pay all accounts owing by the Association which fall within the amount budgeted for specific functions or activities. All other sums owing by the Association must be examined and approved by the President before payment. Immediately following the close of the fiscal year, he shall have the books audited by the President at the Annual Meeting. When his term of office expires, he shall deliver to his successor, or, in his absence, to the President, all books, moneys, and other property of the Association in his Possession.

The Executive Secretary shall receive from the Association a salary to be determined by the Board of Directors; commensurate with the work involved.

**SECTION 5. THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS.** The Board of Directors shall conduct the affairs of the Association and act in an advisory capacity to the President, and shall consider and pass upon such matters as may be referred to it. The policies and work of the Association and its committees shall be governed by the Board of Directors through its officers. The Board shall have complete direction of all finances and property of the Association.

## **ARTICLE VI MEETINGS**

**SECTION 1. ANNUAL MEETING.** There shall be an annual meeting of the Association at such time and place as the Board of Directors may elect. Each member shall be notified by the Executive Secretary at least thirty (30) days prior to each meeting.

**SECTION 2. SPECIAL MEETINGS.** A special meeting of the Association may be called by the President. The Board of Directors, or by written petition of 20 percent or more of the members. Each member shall be notified, by mail, fax, or e-mail by the Executive Secretary at least ten days prior to each meeting.

**SECTION 3. EMERGENCY MEETINGS.** When a meeting of the Association is impracticable, the Board of Directors is empowered to carry on all regular business, including the admission of new members and passing resolutions. Furthermore the Board, under such emergency conditions, may call an election by mail ballot of officers and Board of Directors.

**SECTION 4. QUORUM.** Twenty (20) companies registered at meetings shall constitute a quorum.

**SECTION 5. VOTING.** Each member, Active, Associate and Affiliate, shall be entitled to one vote at any meeting of the Association. All firms, partnerships, or corporations represented at any meeting by more than one person, shall give authority to the person empowered to cast its vote. Individuals, associated with any member shall be entitled to vote at all meetings.

A majority vote shall govern on all matters except election of members (Article I, Section 5) and Amendments to these, By-laws (Article VIII, Section 1.)

**SECTION 6. BOARD OF DIRECTORS' MEETINGS.** Annual meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held at the time and place of the annual meeting of the members and as soon after the election of the annual Board of Directors as is convenient. There shall be a mid-winter meeting of the Board of Directors. At other times the Board shall meet upon call of the President or any five Directors. Written notice shall be sent to each Director by the Executive Secretary at least ten (10) days prior to each meeting. Excepting those meetings held during any Association meeting, when notice is to be given verbally. This ten-day notice may be waived for any specific meeting upon the consent of the Directors. Six (6) members of the Board shall constitute a quorum. Written proxies will be honored.

## **ARTICLE VII ARBITRATION**

**SECTION 1.** The arbitration of all disputes specified in this Article VII shall be conducted in accordance with Commercial Arbitration Rules of the American Arbitration Association, as in effect on November 1, 1973, or as thereafter amended, which said Rules hereby are adopted as the Arbitration Rules for the Pacific Seedsmen's Association, with the exception that unless otherwise specified by agreement of the parties all disputes shall be submitted in writing in accordance with and in the manner prescribed by Section 36 of said Arbitration Rules.

**SECTION 2.** Any controversial claim arising out of or relating to a contract or breach thereof involving business transactions between members of the Pacific Seedsmen's Association shall, unless otherwise specified, be settled by arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association as provided in Section I of this Article. Members of the Pacific Seed Association shall not be required to arbitrate disputes with non-members of the Association by virtue of any provision herein contained except to the extent and in accordance with the provision of Section 3 of this Article.

**SECTION 3.** Unless otherwise specified, any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to a contract or breach thereof involving business transactions between a member of the Pacific Seedsmen's Association and a member of the American Seed Trade Association, a state or regional seed association of United States or a seed trade association of another country, shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the Rules of the American Arbitration Association as hereinafter prescribed; provided that such seed association has adopted identical arbitration procedure and has amended its By-laws to require its members to arbitrate such disputes and to impose disciplinary action against any member failing to arbitrate or abide by the award.

This Section shall not be binding on members of the Pacific Seed Association until the American Seed Trade Association and such state or regional seed association of the United States or a seed trade association of another country, has given official notice to the Executive Secretary of the Pacific Seed Association that it has adopted identical arbitration procedures and has duly amended its By-laws as provided for in this Section.

**SECTION 4.** Members of the Pacific Seed Association who fail or refuse to abide by the arbitration procedures prescribed in this Article or who fail to perform an award within ten (10) days from the date of the rendition thereof shall be subject to disciplinary action as provided in Article II of these By-laws.
